F. FEES & PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The undersigned parent or legal guardian (the "Parent") of the minor participant (the "Participant") and the Participant hereby agree to the terms and conditions set forth herein regarding Participant's application to participate in any programs (the "Program" or "Programs") provided by PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL.

1. Payment Method/Fees: PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL will accept the following methods of payment:

By Credit Card – All credit card payments are subject to a 5.00% administration fee.

By Bank wire transfer – no administration fee charged (free)

2. Payment of Program Fees: The amount to be paid to PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL by the Participant, and the schedule of payments depends on the Program that the Participant chooses to enroll in. Payment schedules are set forth below. In all cases, a deposit in EUROS is required upon submission of this application by the Participant.

3. Programs:

3.1 - 10-MONTH DAY PROGRAM:

Payment 1 – A 495.00 EUROS non-refundable administration fee and a non-refundable deposit of 3,500.00 EUROS for a total of €3,995.00 EUROS is required upon submission of the course application;

Payment 2 – 60% (sixty percent) of the Program fee balance (9,600.00 EUROS) due (1st August 2025) 45 (forty-five) days before the start date of the Program (start date 15th September 2025);

Payment 3 – Balance of Program fee (€ 6,400.00) EUROS due (8th December 2025) thirty (30) days before the start date of the Program's 2nd Term (start date: 7th January, 2026)

3.2 – 11-MONTH DAY PROGRAM:

Payment 1 – A 495.00 EUROS non-refundable administration fee and a non-refundable deposit of 4,500.00 EUROS for a total of 4,995.00 EUROS is required upon submission of the course application;

Payment 2 – 60% (sixty percent) of the Program fee balance (10,200.00 EUROS) due (1st August 2025) 45 (forty-five) days before the start date of the Program (start date 15th September, 2025);

Payment 3 – Balance of Program fee (€ 6,800.00) EUROS due (8th December 2025) thirty (30) days before the start date of the Program's 2nd Term (start date: 7th January, 2026)

G. CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

1. Cancellation/Refund Policy:

PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL makes financial commitments on the Participant's behalf to service providers and affiliated educational institutions. It is obligated to secure and pay these overseas and domestic program partners for many aspects of the program, including but not limited to Health Insurance, Letter of Acceptance (LOA), Accommodation, Language Course Fees, soccer/football training coaches, the rental fees for the pitches and school facilities and any other services as required to support the program. As a result, refunds can only be extended to Participants according to the schedule and for the amounts listed below:

1.1 Cancellation and Refunds for the 10-MONTH PROGRAM

If cancellation occurs 90 or more days before the start of the Program, the Participant will be refunded all amounts paid except for the non-refundable fees: €495.00 non-refundable administration fee and the €3,500.00 non-fundable deposit;

If cancellation occurs less than 30 days prior to the start date of Program, the Participant will not be refunded.

No refunds will be provided in cases where the Participant of a program chooses to permanently withdraw upon or after the start date of such Program.

**Although non-refundable, the registration fee may be transferable to another PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL Program in exceptional circumstances and at the sole discretion of an authorized representative of PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL.*

1.2 Cancellation and Refunds for the 11-MONTH PROGRAM + PRESEASON

If cancellation occurs 90 or more days before the start of the Program, the Participant will be refunded all amounts paid except for the non-refundable fees: €495.00 non-refundable administration fee and the €4,500.00 non-fundable deposit;

If cancellation occurs less than 30 days prior to the start date of Program, the Participant will not be refunded.

No refunds will be provided in cases where the Participant of a program chooses to permanently withdraw upon or after the start date of such Program.

**Although non-refundable, the registration fee may be transferable to another PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL Program in exceptional circumstances and at the sole discretion of an authorized representative of PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL.*

2. Termination for Non-payment or Late Payment:

PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL may terminate this Agreement if the Participant fails to make any payment due as per the terms and conditions of this Agreement and fails to cure such breach within 30 days (thirty) after written notice thereof; provided, however, notwithstanding the foregoing, PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL may terminate this Agreement (without opportunity for the Participant to cure) in the event that the Participant fails twice in the aggregate to make payment on or before the original due date.

H. PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **Lost or stolen Property:**

PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL is not responsible for any inconvenience or expense incurred by an incident of lost or stolen property. All of the Participant's belongings and valuables are the responsibility of the Participant. PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL will provide support to the Participant if an incident occurs, inform the local police of the incident, and help the Participant file a lost/stolen report.

2. **Incident/accident outside of the Proformance Football Program:**

PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL is not responsible for any incident/accident that occurs outside of the supervision of any PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL Program. PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL staff must be informed and give authorization to any Participant who wishes to take part in an activity outside the Program. A parental permission release form is required to be signed by the Participant's parent/ legal guardian to release PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL from any responsibility while the Participant has left the program. If the Participant leaves the Program without consent or the required release form, they do so at their own risk without prejudice.

3. **Additional Charges:**

3.1 Incidental Charges: Parent and/or Participant are responsible for all incidental charges to Participant including but not limited to, laundry service, telephone charges, movie/television charges, taxi service, extra snacks purchased, or others.

3.2 Physical Damage Caused by Participant: The parent and/or Participant are responsible for and will be charged for all physical property damage caused by Participant. Property damage includes but is not limited to, any physical property, including offices, classrooms, pitches, or dormitory premises (and any property belonging to such) where Participant is staying and/ or using during the Program; any physical property located on school premises (and any property belonging to such school) where Participant is studying during Program; any physical property located on sports training facility (and any property belonging to such facility) where Participant is training during Program; as well as any property belonging to any other Participant, Monitor, or Staff Member of the Program.

4. **Insurance/Injuries:**

4.1 Insurance: PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL is not responsible for events out of its control during any of its Programs, which include, but are not limited to, instances of theft, burglary, assault, injury, loss of property, medical emergencies, or other medical needs, acts of terrorism, Acts of God, or any other which may arise. Accordingly, the Parent agrees to procure, on behalf of the Participant, personal insurance necessary to cover all costs incurred by the Participant in the Program. The parent agrees to provide PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL with evidence of said insurance 30 days before the Participant starts the Program. If the Participant is covered by the Spanish national health system, that is acceptable and will not require additional private health insurance unless the Participant travels abroad during the Program, for a tournament or other extra activity. If evidence of the necessary insurance is not provided accordingly, PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL reserve the right to deny Participant participation in the program. The Parent and Participant acknowledge that it is his/her responsibility to understand the limitations of their insurance coverage and agree that PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL is in no way responsible for any losses not covered by the insurance policy.

H. PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

5. **Injury to Participant:** Injuries sustained by the Participant while attending a PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL Program, especially those involving football/soccer training and/or participation in a match, WILL NOT result in a refund. Injuries are an unfortunate part of participation in a sport and are to be expected. However, PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL cannot recuperate the fixed cost of food, room and board, transportation, and all other expenses associated with a Participant's attendance in a PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL Program. If the Participant needs to leave a Program due to injury, flights and other transportation must be arranged by the Parent at the Parent's expense. The Participant must ensure that he/ she has adequate health insurance for the duration of the course.
6. **Travel Documentation:** The procurement of any passport, visas, or other required travel documents necessary to participate in the Program is the sole and absolute responsibility of the Parent and Participant. Copies of all travel documents should be kept by participants and Parents in the event of an emergency. Whether a European citizen or not, the Participant shall hold PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL harmless in the event the Participant cannot obtain the necessary documents for participation in the PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL Program. The Participant further understands that the inability to obtain visas and other documents does not constitute grounds for a refund or waiver of any Program fees.
7. **Agreement to Abide by Performance Football Policy:** Parent and Participant acknowledge that each has read and understand the Policies contained in this Policy Page, as well as the Code of Conduct attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference and agree to abide by them. Failure to comply with the Policies of PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL and the Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action of Participant including, but not limited to, dismissal from the Program at the sole and absolute discretion of PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL. If Participant is dismissed from a Program for failure to comply with the Policies of PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL, Parent and Participant agree that:
 - (a) the full cost of returning home is at the Parent and Participant's sole expense, and
 - (b) the Participant will not receive a refund of any Program Fees because of the dismissal.

Parent and Participant further agree that participation in the Program may be terminated if Participant is expelled, suspended, or otherwise disciplined from a partner school or by civil authorities or if PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL, in its sole and absolute discretion, determines that Participant's conduct is incompatible with the interests, safety or welfare of other participants in the Program. Parent and Participant agree to indemnify PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL if PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL sustains any financial loss or liability because of the actions of Participant.

8. **Hold Harmless:** Parent and Participant hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL, its officers, directors, employees, shareholders, affiliates, agents, and representatives, from and against all damages, losses, claims, liabilities, deficiencies costs, fees (including reasonable attorneys' fees), and expenses arising out of or resulting from participation by Participant in any PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL Program.
9. **Limitation of Liability:** IN NO EVENT SHALL PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY CONSEQUENTIAL, INDIRECT, EXEMPLARY, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES OF ANY KIND, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION, DAMAGES FOR ANY LOSS OF OPPORTUNITY OR OTHER PECUNIARY LOSS, WHETHER SUCH LIABILITY IS BASED UPON CONTRACT, TORT, NEGLIGENCE OR OTHER LEGAL THEORY OTHER THAN THE INTENTIONAL MISCONDUCT OR WILLFUL MALFEASANCE OF PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL. IN NO EVENT SHALL PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL'S TOTAL AGGREGATE LIABILITY TO THE PARTICIPANT UNDER CLAIMS ARISING UNDER THIS AGREEMENT EXCEED THE TOTAL AMOUNTS PAID BY THE PARENT AND PARTICIPANT TO PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL.

H. PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

10. Dispute Resolution Policies and Grievance Procedures: If the Participant has a complaint with any part of a program, the following grievance procedures must be followed:

- (a) The Participant will address all such complaints, concerns, conflicts, or related problems immediately and directly with the appropriate PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL representative. At this time, PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL and/or its partner organization will attempt to rectify the problem by working directly with the Participant by offering a proposed solution (s).
- (b) If PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL or its partner organization are unable to devise a mutually acceptable solution, the Participant or Parent must complete an official complaint form (which can be acquired from a PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL representative or that of its partner) and submit it directly to the appropriate representative and the Program Coordinator with whom the Participant enrolled for that specific program at PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL headquarters in a further attempt to rectify any conflict. The complaint form will then be reviewed by the Program Coordinator, who will discuss the specifics with the appropriate representative and the Participant. Further solutions to resolve the complaint will then be presented to the Participant, one of which must be accepted by the Participant or Parent within reason.
- (c) If all proposed solutions have not rectified the problem and the Participant still feels the situation, including all proposed solutions, are unreasonable, the Participant or Parent must notify the management at PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL head office in writing and explain the full details of the situation. At this stage, a decision will be made by PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL, at its sole discretion, whether a refund of any amount is warranted. All decisions made by PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL, in its sole discretion, are final.
- (d) If the Participant leaves the Program before exhausting all grievance procedures, no refunds will be provided, and no further recourse is available to the Participant from that point forward.

11. Use of Information: PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL occasionally uses photographs of its Program Participants on its website and print marketing materials. The Parents and the Participant consent to the use of such photographs. The Participant agrees that PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL may add the Participant's name and email address to an email distribution list which will be shared with other Participants on a PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL Program, unless PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL is otherwise notified in writing.

12. Miscellaneous:

- (a) **Entire Agreement:** This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding and agreement of the parties with respect to its subject matter, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous understandings and agreements, whether written or oral, with respect to such subject matter.
- (b) **Governing Law:** This Agreement shall be governed and construed in all respects by and in accordance with the laws of Spain.
- (c) **Notices:** Any notices required or permitted hereunder shall be given to PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL at the address specified below or at such other address PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL shall specify in writing and to Parent and or Participant at the address specified on the Program application or at such other address as Parent and/or Participant shall provide in writing to PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL. Such notice shall be deemed given upon personal delivery if sent by email upon confirmation of receipt or if sent by certified or registered mail, postage prepaid, three (3) days after the date of mailing.

- (d) **Costs of Prevailing Party:** If either party brings an action to enforce the terms of this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover all costs and expenses, including attorneys' fees, from the other party within reason.
- (e) **Counterparts:** This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which together shall constitute one and the same Agreement.

I. EXHIBIT A PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT

1. **Participant Code of Conduct:** Participants in PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL Programs are expected to respect themselves, their peers, their coaches, teachers, staff, family, friends, and others. Participants will abide by the rules of conduct at PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL and act accordingly as per the coaches, teachers, and staff's instructions.
The following actions can lead to suspension and/or expulsion from the PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL Program in which Participant is enrolled, and **no refund** will be provided.
 - (a) Refusal to participate in an activity or refusing to follow instructions is **NOT** tolerated
 - (b) Disrespecting your peers, teachers, coaches, staff, or others is **NOT** tolerated
 - (c) Gross misconduct, including but not limited to stealing, harassment, aggression, destruction of property, abuse, or other is **NOT** tolerated
2. **Participant Responsibility:** Participants are subject to local laws, standards of living, and all that comes with living in Spain. Participants are responsible for understanding issues related to the legal, cultural, safety, health, political, and religious issues in Spain. Participants are responsible for themselves and their actions. Participants are expected to respect people, customs, property, laws, and all other aspects of life.
3. **Security:** PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL or its partners cannot be solely responsible for the Participant's security. Each Participant is responsible for one's safety and therefore should be constantly aware of their environment and the situations they put themselves in. Any activity that endangers oneself or another participant in a PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL program is unacceptable. A Participant who knowingly and purposely engages in such behaviour may be asked to leave the program with no refund at the sole discretion of PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL.
4. **Drugs, Alcohol, and Weapons:** PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL **WILL NOT** tolerate any involvement, be it consumption, sales, or possession, of alcohol, drugs, any other illegal substances, and/or weapons of any kind. Should PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL or its affiliated partners learn of any such activity, unlawful drinking of alcoholic beverages, or illegal purchases, those Participants will be immediately expelled from the PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL Program in which they are enrolled, and **no refund** will be provided.
5. **Program Activity Attendance:** Participants must attend all classes and soccer training to keep up with the group. Each Participant is expected to maintain 100% attendance to all scheduled activities (including sports, language classes, social activities, etc.). If deemed by PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL or its partners that a participant has failed to attend courses in accordance with their program requirements, PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL at its sole discretion may dismiss the Participant from the Program with no refund provided.
6. **Free Time:** Participants should be aware that PRFORMANCE FOOTBALL Programs are academic and athletic and that "free time" is limited. Please note, however, that there will be occasional "downtime" between activities when Participants will be responsible for entertaining themselves for short periods. This time is intended for rest, personal time, to study, etc. PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL Programs are designed to be group activities and thus, we expect all Participants to engage in all activities. PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL bilingual professional staff provides daily supervision of Participants. Participants will **NOT** be allowed to travel apart from the group at any time without explicit permission by a PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL staff member. Parents **CANNOT** provide "special permission" for Participants to engage in any activity that is not part of the regular PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL curriculum. Participants are expected to arrive in a timely matter at all times to group activities. PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL reserves the right to dismiss a Participant that knowingly violates these rules.

I. EXHIBIT A PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT

7. Local Customs and Laws: Participant and Parent understand and agree that the Program takes place in Spain. For some Participants, Spain is a foreign country, with different customs, standards, laws, and risks to which Participants may be unaccustomed. Participant understands and acknowledges that;

- (a) he/she may not agree with local customs and standards;
- (b) he/she may be arrested and/or imprisoned upon acts committed in violation of local laws;
- (c) there exists crime in foreign countries and that he/she may be a victim of such crime.

Participant and Parent understand and accept the above-described risks and other risks associated with living in a foreign country. Participants and Parents understand that they are responsible for always exercising caution and common sense and agree to release and not hold PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL responsible for any such problems encountered while participating in a PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL Program.

8. PLAYERS CODE OF ETHICS:

- (a) Participant agree to arrive at training sessions on time with all equipment (water, shin guards, shoes tied, soccer ball, practice uniform) and be ready to participate at the scheduled start time. On time is 15 minutes before scheduled time.
- (b) Participant agrees not to wear jewelry during soccer events.
- (c) Participant agrees to attend all training. Excused training sessions will be due to illness, an academic conflict or a religious conflict, or at the coach's approval. If you are going to miss training for one of these 3 reasons, you must **notify the coach BEFORE** the training session.
- (d) Participant agrees to be ready to begin warm-ups at least 45 minutes before game time unless a different time frame is specified by the Director of Coaching or PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL coaching/training staff.
- (e) Participant agrees to follow curfew and scheduled times at all soccer events.
- (f) Participant agrees to encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, coaches, officials and parents at all times. I
- (g) Participant agrees to remember that football/soccer is an opportunity to learn and have fun.
- (h) Participant agrees to do the best he/she can each day, remembering that all players have talents and weaknesses the same as you do.
- (i) Participant agrees to treat my coaches, other players and coaches, match officials, other administrators, and fans with respect at all times; regardless of race, sex, creed or abilities
- (j) Participant agrees to concentrate on playing football/soccer, always giving their best effort and having a positive attitude.
- (k) Participant agrees to play by the rules at all times.
- (l) Participant agrees to control their temper at all times, resisting the temptation to retaliate.
- (m) Participant agrees to control their words at all times, resisting the temptation to use profanity.
- (n) Participant agrees to always handle themselves at all football/soccer events on behalf of PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL in a way that will make the academy proud as well as family and friends.

Failure to comply with the PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL Code of Ethics and the General Code of Conduct (EXHIBIT A) may result in the suspension of the Participant's privilege to participate in the Program for the following periods:

1st offense: Suspension for a minimum of two (2) days to a maximum of five (5) days.

2nd offense: Suspension for a minimum of five (5) days to a maximum of ten (10) days.

3rd offense: Suspension for a minimum of ten (10) days and can lead to being expelled from the Program with **no refund**.

PROFORMANCE FOOTBALL - Release & Hold Harmless Agreement

I as parent/player/guardian understand and acknowledge that my child will be engaging in athletic and related activities as a member of PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL, which activities may be dangerous and which may result in physical injury to my child. I understand and acknowledge that injuries sustained by my child may be serious and may result in medical or surgical treatment. I am fully aware of the risks associated with these activities and with that knowledge;

I hereby allow my child to participate in all such athletic and related activities and voluntarily assume said risks. I further hereby release and agree to indemnify and hold harmless PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL, its, officers, directors, coaches, volunteers, employees and agents, from and for any liability for all losses, injuries, medical expenses, damages of any nature, form, or description, and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees and costs at all stages of any legal proceeding including, but not limited to, trial, appellate, and post-judgment proceedings), for any injuries or damages sustained by my child as a result of, or in any way arising out of, his/her participation in PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL which losses, injuries, medical expenses, damages, and expenses exceed any other private or governmental entity, or any personal policy of insurance insuring my child. This release and hold harmless agreement does not apply to, nor shall it inure to the benefit of, any individual or entity that is not specifically associated with PERFORMANCE FOOTBALL as described above, whose negligence or intentional acts have resulted in injuries or damages to my child.
